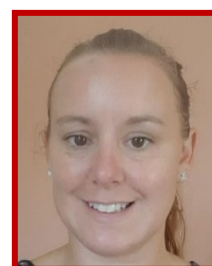
Nursery Team (including 2yr olds) - Miss Ashley

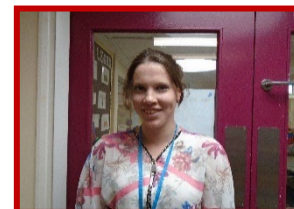

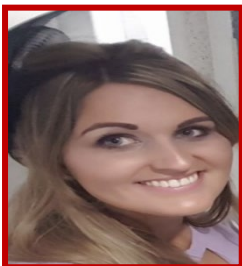
Class 1

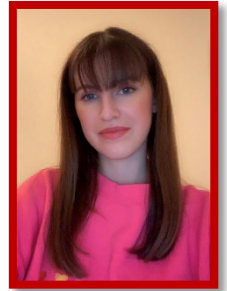

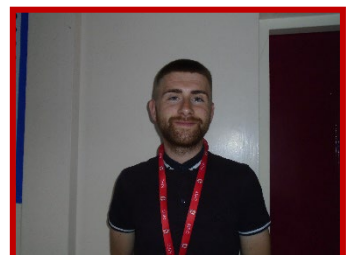
Class 10 Teacher

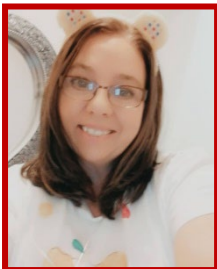
Miss Thorpe

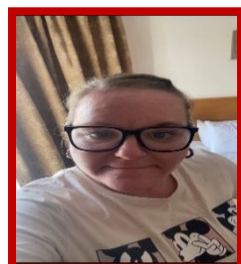

Hi I'm Miss Ramsey, I'm looking forward to the next year watching your children grow and thrive. I enjoy reading, socialising and being with my children.



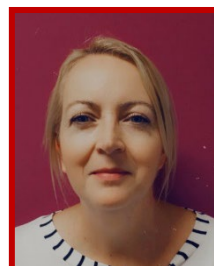

Hi I am Mrs Gatenby I came to St John's for the last year. I am looking forward to working in with your children. In my spare time I love spending with family and friends.



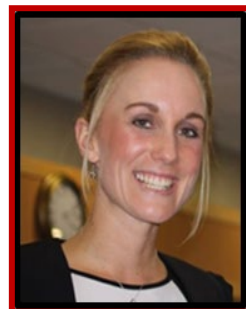
Senior Leadership team

In addition to this, we have Mrs Conroy and Mrs Ogden as Designated Safeguarding Officers.

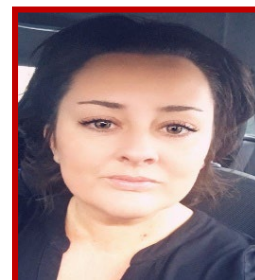
We work together to ensure we promote the welfare of everyone in school and act in the best interests of the children.
